A BILL

- 1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for the 2 regulation of methods, procedures and specifications for
- 3 trapping and snaring through rule and regulation; providing
- 4 time periods for the checking of snares and traps;
- 5 providing for exceptions; and providing for an effective
- 6 date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-2-303(d) and (e), by creating a
- 11 new subsection (e) and by renumbering subsections (e) and
- 12 (f) as (f) and (g) are amended to read:

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1 23-2-303. Trapping licenses; tagging; traps and

2 snares; penalty; confiscation; inspection; interference

with trapping.

(d)

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5 The commission, following consultation with other 6 affected governmental entities, may promulgate rules and 7 regulations governing the methods, procedures and specifications for trapping and snaring of furbearing and 8 9 predatory animals. All traps and snares 10 furbearing or predatory animals shall be permanently marked 11 or tagged with the name and address of the owner or the 12 identification number assigned to the owner by 13 department. Any identification number attached to a trap 14 or snare pursuant to this subsection is solely for the use of the department or appropriate law enforcement officers 15 and is not a public record for purposes of W.S. 16-4-201 16 17 through 16-4-205. No trap or snare shall be set for 18 furbearing or predatory animals within thirty (30) feet of any exposed bait or carcass over five (5) pounds in weight. 19 As used in this subsection, "exposed bait or carcass" means 20 21 the meat or viscera of any part of a mammal, bird or fish, excluding dried bones. In addition, All snares used for 22 23 taking furbearing or predatory animals shall be equipped with a break-away locking device. that is designed to

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2 release at two hundred ninety five (295) pounds of pressure 3 or less and a snare loop not to exceed twelve (12) inches in diameter measured side to side. Unless otherwise 4 5 specified in this section subsection, all steel-jawed 6 leghold traps, excluding snares set for furbearing animals 7 and predatory animals and quick kill body grip traps as defined by commission rule and regulation, shall be checked 8 by the owner at least once during each seventy-two (72) 9 10 hour period from the time the traps were set. All snares 11 and quick kill body grip traps shall be checked by the 12 owner not less than once each seven (7) day period week from the time the snares or traps were set. The commission 13 14 may through rule and regulation allow exceptions to trap and snare check periods. All wildlife caught in any trap 15 16 or snare shall upon discovery, be removed immediately by 17 the owner. Violation of this subsection constitutes a low 18 misdemeanor punishable as provided in W.S. 23-6-202(a)(v). 19 20 (e) After the date gray wolves are removed from the 21 list of experimental nonessential population, endangered

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9 (e)(f) Any trap or snare found in the field not 10 bearing the name and address of the owner of the trap or

11 snare or the identification number assigned by the

12 department to the owner of the trap or snare may be

13 confiscated by any employee of the department. Any

14 landowner or his agent may inspect any trap or snare set on

15 his property and may remove the trap or snare and release

16 or remove from the trap or snare any wildlife which has not

17 been taken lawfully. The landowner or his agent shall

18 **immediately** notify the department of any such wildlife,

19 excluding predatory animals, prior to immediately after

20 removing the wildlife from a trap or snare.

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 $\frac{(f)}{(g)}$ A violation of this subsection constitutes a

23 low misdemeanor punishable as provided in W.S.

- 1 23-6-202(a)(v). Except as otherwise provided in this
- 2 section, no person shall intentionally:

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- 4 (i) Tamper with or remove a trap or snare set
- 5 and maintained in compliance with this act; or

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- 7 (ii) Release or remove a furbearer or predator
- 8 from a trap or snare set and maintained in compliance with
- 9 this act.

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- 11 23-3-103. Taking predatory animals, predacious birds
- 12 and trophy animals; taking furbearing animals and game
- 13 birds without license prohibited.

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- 15 (a) Predatory animals and predacious birds may be
- 16 taken without a license in any manner and at any time
- 17 except as provided by W.S. 23-2-303(d) and (e), 23-3-112,
- 23-3-304(b), 23-3-305 and 23-3-307. The department shall
- 19 report annually to the Wyoming department of agriculture
- 20 the number of predatory animals and predacious birds taken
- 21 by the department's animal damage control agents, and
- 22 include in the report the area where taken and the control
- 23 method used.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
