A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to economic analysis; providing for
2 collecting, compiling, analyzing and distributing county
3 economic data; providing for establishment of uniform data
4 criteria; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1024(a) by creating new
9 paragraphs (vii) through (ix) and by renumbering (vii) as
10 (x) is amended to read:

12 **9-2-1024. Duties performed through division of**
13 **economic analysis.**

1 (a) The department through the division of economic
2 analysis, in cooperation with other governmental and
3 private agencies, shall:

4
5 (vii) Establish uniform criteria for collecting,
6 compiling, analyzing, reporting and distributing economic
7 data for all Wyoming counties related to uses of private,
8 state and federal surface and mineral lands, including but
9 not limited to, the optimum use and development of
10 agriculture, grazing, minerals, timber, water, industrial
11 resources, recreation and energy production, transmission
12 and related services. This data shall be updated at least
13 once every three (3) years;

15 (viii) Collect, compile, analyze, maintain,
16 update, report and consolidate into digest form economic
17 data to identify, analyze and measure economic impacts
18 related to proposed state and federal regulatory or
19 administrative actions that may affect uses of private,
20 state and federal surface and mineral lands, including but
21 not limited to, the optimum use and development of
22 agriculture, grazing, minerals, timber, water, industrial
23 resources, recreation and energy production, transmission
24 and related services;

(ix) Supervise and coordinate statistical, informational or research programs conducted on behalf of counties and establish and maintain a central depository of economic, statistical and other data relative to Wyoming counties;

~~(vii)~~ (x) Prepare an annual catalog listing the type of statistical information available from state agencies and other sources.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
