5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-3-123 is created to read:

9 **8-3-123. State code.**

11 (a) The code of the west, as derived from the book,  
12 Cowboy Ethics by James P. Owen, and summarized as follows,  
13 is the official state code of Wyoming:

15 (i) Live each day with courage;

1 (ii) Take pride in your work;

3 (iii) Always finish what you start;

5 (iv) Do what has to be done;

7 (v) Be tough, but fair;

9 (vi) When you make a promise, keep it;

11 (vii) Ride for the brand;

13 (viii) Talk less, say more;

15 (ix) Remember that some things are not for sale;

17 (x) Know where to draw the line.
