A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to concealed weapons; authorizing the
2 carrying of concealed weapons by persons without a
3 concealed weapon permit as specified; amending a
4 restriction on where a concealed firearm may be carried;
5 specifying penalties for a second or subsequent offense;
6 and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-8-104(a)(ii), (iii), by creating a
11 new paragraph (iv) and (t)(intro) is amended to read:

12

13 **6-8-104. Wearing or carrying concealed weapons;**
14 **penalties; exceptions; permits.**

1 (a) A person who wears or carries a concealed deadly
2 weapon is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of
3 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00),
4 imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6)
5 months, or both for a first offense, or a felony punishable
6 by a fine of not more than two thousand dollars
7 (\$2,000.00), imprisonment for not more than two (2) years,
8 or both, for a second or subsequent offense, unless:

10 (ii) The person possesses a permit under this
11 section;~~or~~

12
13 (iii) The person holds a valid permit
14 authorizing him to carry a concealed firearm authorized and
15 issued by a governmental agency or entity in another state
16 that recognizes Wyoming permits and is a valid statewide
17 permit;~~or~~ or

19 (iv) The person does not possess a permit issued
20 under this section, but otherwise meets the requirements
21 specified in paragraphs (b)(i) through (vi), (viii) and
22 (ix) of this section and possession of the firearm by the
23 person is not otherwise unlawful.

1 (t) No ~~permit issued~~ person authorized to carry a
2 concealed weapon pursuant to paragraphs (a)(ii) through
3 (iv) of this section ~~or any permit issued from any other~~
4 ~~state~~ shall ~~authorize any person to~~ carry a concealed
