- 9 (e) through (g) and 21-18-202(a)(iii) are amended to read:

- 11 21-17-105. Tuition to be as nearly free as possible;
- 12 number, qualifications and selection of students for
- 13 reduced tuition; tuition for veterans; reciprocal
