Catch Title: Wyoming Food Freedom Act.
Subject: Exempts some sales of food from state licensure, certification and inspection.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill enacts the Wyoming Food Freedom Act. The Act:
 - Defines relevant terms, including “farmers market” “home consumption,” “homemade” and “informed end consumer”;
 - Exempts from all state and local licensure, permitting, certification and inspection homemade foods sold directly by a producer to an informed end consumer;
 - Prohibits use of exempted foods in commercial food establishments;
 - Recites the act does not impede the right of the Department of Health to investigate food borne illnesses, or change requirements for brand inspections and animal health inspections.
