Catch Title: Study on management of public lands.

Subject: Requiring a study on the management of public lands in Wyoming by the State of Wyoming.

Summary/Major Elements:

- This bill requires the Office of State Lands and Investments to commission a study addressing the management of specified federally administered public lands in Wyoming by the State of Wyoming.
- This bill authorizes the Office of State Lands and Investments to engage the services of research or consulting firms as necessary to develop the study.
- This bill requires the Office of State Lands to provide a final report to the Select Federal Natural Resource Management Committee no later than November 30, 2016.
- This bill requires the Select Federal Natural Resource Management Committee to consider the study and develop any necessary legislation in response to the study.
- This bill appropriates \$75,000 from the General Fund to the Office of State Lands and Investments for the purpose of commissioning the study and hiring consultants to assist in the study.

Comments:

- Requires a report.
