The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The fiscal impact to the Department of Corrections is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

Assumptions:

There are no current measures that would allow for an accurate prediction of the number of individuals sentenced pursuant to the proposed legislation. Each year of incarceration, per inmate, will cost the State approximately \$45,625, including medical costs. The cost for community supervision of an offender is approximately \$2,000 per year.
