1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; authorizing  
2 construction of designated water projects; describing  
3 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for  
4 projects; providing appropriations; extending the sunset  
5 dates for sponsor's contingency funds; modifying project  
6 descriptions, amounts and terms of appropriations for  
7 specified prior projects; and providing for effective  
8 dates.

10 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 99-3-2201 through 99-3-2205 are  
13 created to read:

2017 CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

**99-3-2201. Definitions.**

The definitions in W.S. 99-3-101 apply to this article.

**99-3-2202. General authorization.**

The provisions of W.S. 99-3-102 apply to this article.

**99-3-2203. Level III construction projects - new development.**

(a) Authorization is granted for the Level III new development construction projects identified in this

1 section subject to the general conditions specified in W.S.  
2 99-3-103.

15 necessary to make the project function in the manner  
16 intended;

18 (iv) Total project budget: Nine hundred fifteen  
19 thousand dollars (\$915,000.00);

20  
21 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall  
22 grant to the sponsor from water development account I  
23 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,  
24 project land procurement, construction engineering and  
25 construction of the project an amount not to exceed six  
26 hundred thirteen thousand fifty dollars (\$613,050.00) or  
27 sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual development costs,  
28 whichever is less;

29  
30 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from  
31 water development account I to the commission six hundred  
32 thirteen thousand fifty dollars (\$613,050.00) or as much  
33 thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this  
34 subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this  
35 subsection shall revert to water development account I on  
36 July 1, 2022;

33 dollars (\$1,991,910.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the  
34 actual development costs, whichever is less;

37 water development account I to the commission one million
