1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; extending the validity  
2 for driver's licenses; and providing for an effective date.

4 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-119(a), (c), (f)(intro) and (i)  
7 is amended to read:

9 **31-7-119. Expiration and renewal; required tests;**  
10 **extension.**

12 (a) Every driver's license shall expire on the  
13 licensee's birthday in the ~~fourth~~fifth year following the  
14 issuance of the license.

15

1 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (f) of this section,  
2 the division may defer the expiration of the license of a  
3 licensee who is on active duty in the armed forces of the  
4 United States for successive ~~four~~ (4) five (5) year  
5 periods, upon terms and conditions as it may prescribe. The  
6 division may similarly defer the expiration of the license  
7 of the spouse or dependent child of the person in the armed  
8 forces if residing with that person.

9  
10 (f) Once in any ~~eight~~ (8) ten (10) year period, a  
11 driver's license may be extended for a ~~four~~ (4) five (5)  
12 year period without the examination required by subsection  
13 (b) of this section for a licensee:

14  
15 (i) Whose license has not been suspended or  
16 revoked in the ~~four~~ (4) five (5) years immediately  
17 preceding the date of license expiration;

19 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
