State institution revenue accounts.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state institutions; providing for the
2 deposit of monies and income received or collected by
3 public institutions into accounts to be expended as
4 specified; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 25-10-129 is created to read:

9

10 **25-10-129. Receipt and disposition of revenues and**
11 **gifts.**

12

13 The department is authorized to deposit all monies and
14 income received and collected by the Wyoming state hospital
15 into a special revenue account. The department shall expend
16 this revenue to correct life safety code problems, pay for

1 the cost of emergency detentions pursuant to W.S.
2 25-10-109, pay for the costs of involuntary
3 hospitalizations pursuant to W.S. 25-10-110, and remediate
4 conditions at the state hospital as identified in
5 settlement agreements which are approved by the director
6 and reported to the governor. If any single capital project
7 is anticipated to exceed two hundred thousand dollars
8 (\$200,000.00), it shall be approved by the state building
9 commission. The department shall report to the joint
10 appropriations committee not later than November 1 of each
11 year detailing expenditures under this section.

13 **Section 2.** W.S. 9-4-303 and 25-8-104 are amended to
14 read:

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16 **9-4-303. Payment of monies and income into state**
17 **treasury.**

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19 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, all monies
20 and income received or collected by any public institution
21 of this state for the care of patients therein, for the
22 maintenance of prisoners therein, or as compensation for
23 any matter whatsoever, received from the institution, shall

1 be paid into the state treasury as frequently as their
2 procedure and their location will permit and credited to
3 the general fund and shall not be paid out except in
4 pursuance of a lawful appropriation. The legislature may
5 provide for the deposit of monies and income received or
6 collected by any public institution of this state into
7 other accounts provided those funds shall be expended to
8 further the mission of the public institution as provided
9 by law.

11 (b) Except as otherwise provided by law all monies
12 donated to any public institution or organization belonging
13 to the state, whether educational, charitable, military or
14 of other public nature, and any and all monies donated to
15 the state for the use or benefit of the institutions and
16 organizations shall be deposited in the state treasury in
17 the appropriate accounts and shall not be withdrawn except
18 in the manner provided in W.S. 9-4-304. The legislature may
19 provide for the deposit of monies donated to any public
20 institution or organization of this state into a separate
21 fund provided those monies shall be expended to further the
22 mission of the public institution or organization as
23 provided by law.

2 **25-8-104. Receipt and disposition of revenues and**
3 **gifts.**

4

5 (a) All revenues received from the operation of the
6 pioneer home ~~and the Wyoming retirement center~~ and from
7 gifts given for the general purpose of the pioneer home ~~and~~
8 ~~the Wyoming retirement center~~ shall be paid over to the
9 state treasurer and deposited in the general fund. Gifts
10 given for a specific purpose shall be kept in a separate
11 account to be expended by the department of health for the
12 specific purpose.

13

14 (b) The department shall deposit all funds received,
15 collected by or donated to the Wyoming retirement center
16 for care of patients into the special revenue fund. The
17 funds collected are appropriated to the department and
18 shall only be expended to fund the operation of the Wyoming
19 retirement center and shall be disbursed pursuant to W.S.
20 9-4-304.

1 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
