Local government procurement-notice.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to local government procurement procedures;
2 requiring local governments and other entities to provide
3 notice of procurement activities as specified; providing
4 exceptions; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1038, 15-1-131 and 18-2-116 are
9 created to read:

11 **9-2-1038. Purchasing for cities, towns, counties,**
12 **special districts, joint powers boards and political**
13 **subdivision; notice.**

1 Unless another method of notice is required by law, every
2 city, town, county, special district, joint powers board
3 and political subdivision thereof procuring supplies or
4 services in an amount in excess of seven thousand five
5 hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) shall provide notice of any
6 opportunity for members of the public to bid or submit
7 proposals for the provision of the supplies or services on
8 an internet website or by other electronic means. The
9 notice shall provide all information necessary for an
10 interested person to bid or otherwise submit a proposal,
11 shall be posted sufficiently before any deadline for bids
12 or proposals to allow reasonable notice and opportunity to
13 respond and shall be accessible to all members of the
14 public. Unless otherwise required by law, compliance with
15 this section shall relieve a city, town, county, special
16 district, joint powers board or political subdivision
17 thereof of the obligation to print, post, advertise or
18 otherwise provide notice of the opportunity to bid or
19 submit proposals.

21 **15-1-131. Additional procurement, bidding and**
22 **contracting procedures.**

1 Except as otherwise provided by law, cities, towns and
2 their political subdivisions shall comply with the notice
3 procedures required by W.S. 9-2-1038.

4

5 **18-2-116. Additional procurement, bidding and**
6 **contracting procedures.**

7

8 Except as otherwise provided by law, counties and their
9 political subdivisions shall comply with the notice
10 procedures required by W.S. 9-2-1038.

11

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
