**Catch Title:** School safety and security.

**Subject:** Concealed Carry Firearms: Schools.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This act authorizes a board of trustees of a school district to adopt rules, in consultation with local law enforcement, to allow school district employees who hold a valid concealed carry permit to carry a concealed firearm on school district property and in school district facilities.
- Promulgation of appropriate rules is required for an employee to be allowed to carry a concealed firearm and an employee must receive express approval of a school district to carry a firearm on school district property or in a school district facility.
- The rules, if promulgated, must contain: an application, approval, and revocation process; require the employee to carry the firearm on his person or maintain the firearm in a concealed biometric container or lockbox; and establish initial and ongoing training requirements (which may be waived for rural schools).
- The act provides for notice for parents and guardians of students and law enforcement agencies.
