14 (i) Project sponsor: Savery-Little Snake Water
15 Conservancy District;

17 (ii) Project purpose: Agricultural water supply;

18

19 (iii) Project description: Construction of a new dam
20 on the West Fork Battle Creek to create a reservoir impoundment
21 of approximately ten thousand acre-feet (10,000 AF) and
22 appurtenances necessary to make the project function in the
23 manner intended;

25 (iv) Total project budget: Seventy-three million
26 dollars (\$73,000,000.00);

27

28 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall grant
29 to the sponsor from water development account III through the
30 commission for project land procurement, construction
31 engineering and construction of the project an amount not to
32 exceed ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00);

33

34 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from water
35 development account III to the commission ten million dollars
36 (\$10,000,000.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry out
37 the purpose of this subsection. This appropriation is a partial
38 appropriation of the total seventy-three million dollars
39 (\$73,000,000.00) required to complete the project. Additional
40 appropriations and funding sources shall be identified to
41 provide full funding for the project before any bids are let for
42 construction, excluding land acquisition. Unexpended funds

1 appropriated under this subsection shall revert to water
2 development account III on July 1, 2021;

4 (viii) Special conditions: Funds from this
5 appropriation shall not be expended until the project sponsor
6 and the Wyoming water development commission have secured
7 additional funding commitments from project beneficiaries in
8 both Wyoming and Colorado on a pro rata basis. Funds from this
9 appropriation shall not be expended until the expenditure is
