1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; authorizing
 2 construction of designated water projects; describing
 3 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for
 4 projects; providing appropriations; modifying project
 5 descriptions, amounts and terms of appropriations for
 6 specified prior projects; and providing for an effective
 7 date.

3 The definitions in W.S. 99-3-101 apply to this article.

5 **99-3-2302. General authorization.**

9 **99-3-2303. Level III construction projects - new**
10 **development.**

11

12 (a) Authorization is granted for the Level III new
13 development construction projects identified in this
14 section subject to the general conditions specified in W.S.
15 99-3-103.

16

17 (b) Project - Gillette Regional Extensions Phase
18 IV - 2018:

20 (i) Project sponsor: City of Gillette;

21

22 (ii) Project purpose: Municipal and rural
23 domestic water supply;

1

2 (iii) Project description: Design and
3 construction of transmission pipelines and appurtenances
4 necessary to make the project function in the manner
5 intended;

6

7 (iv) Total project budget: Two million seven
8 hundred thousand dollars (\$2,700,000.00);

9

10 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
11 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
12 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
13 project land procurement, construction engineering and
14 construction of the project an amount not to exceed one
15 million eight hundred nine thousand dollars (\$1,809,000.00)
16 or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual development
17 costs, whichever is less;

18

19 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
20 water development account I to the commission one million
21 eight hundred nine thousand dollars (\$1,809,000.00) or as
22 much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of
23 this subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this

2 July 1, 2023;

21 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
22 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
23 project land procurement, construction engineering and

1 construction of the project an amount not to exceed five
2 hundred forty-six thousand fifty dollars (\$546,050.00) or
3 sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual development costs,
4 whichever is less;

5
6 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
7 water development account I to the commission five hundred
8 forty-six thousand fifty dollars (\$546,050.00) or as much
9 thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of this
10 subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this
11 subsection shall revert to water development account I on

7 hundred ninety-five thousand eight hundred dollars
8 (\$495,800.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual
9 development costs, whichever is less;

10

11 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
12 water development account I to the commission four hundred
13 ninety-five thousand eight hundred dollars (\$495,800.00) or
14 as much thereof as is necessary to carry out the purpose of
15 this subsection. Unexpended funds appropriated under this
16 subsection shall revert to water development account I on
17 July 1, 2023;

7 drilled during the level II study for a price not to exceed
8 thirty-three percent (33%) of the well's actual
9 construction costs. The sponsor shall purchase the well
10 with a lump sum payment.

7 (v) Project grant: The state of Wyoming shall
8 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
9 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
10 project land procurement, construction engineering and
11 construction of the project an amount not to exceed one
12 million seventy-six thousand six hundred ninety dollars
13 (\$1,076,690.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual
14 development costs, whichever is less;

15
16 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
17 water development account I to the commission one million
18 seventy-six thousand six hundred ninety dollars
19 (\$1,076,690.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry
20 out the purpose of this subsection. Unexpended funds

22 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
23 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,

1 project land procurement, construction engineering and
2 construction of the project an amount not to exceed one
3 million seven hundred thirty-five thousand three hundred
4 dollars (\$1,735,300.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the
5 actual development costs, whichever is less;

6

7 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
8 water development account I to the commission one million
9 seven hundred thirty-five thousand three hundred dollars
10 (\$1,735,300.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry

13 grant to the sponsor from water development account I
14 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
15 project land procurement, construction engineering and
16 construction of the project an amount not to exceed seven
17 hundred twenty-two thousand nine hundred thirty dollars
18 (\$722,930.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual
19 development costs, whichever is less;

20

21 (vi) Appropriation: There is appropriated from
22 water development account I to the commission seven hundred
23 twenty-two thousand nine hundred thirty dollars

1 (\$722,930.00) or as much thereof as is necessary to carry

4 development office one hundred thirty thousand dollars

6 out the purpose of this subsection. Unexpended funds
7 appropriated under this subsection shall revert to water
8 development account I on July 1, 2020;
