State building construction-legislative review.

Sponsored by: Senator(s) Bebout

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state property and buildings; requiring
2 that specified agencies' needs assessments and construction
3 and renovation priorities be submitted by the state
4 building commission to the legislature as specified;
5 requiring legislative approval of capital construction
6 projects as specified; specifying applicability; and
7 providing for an effective date.

9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-5-114 is created to read:

12

13 **9-5-114. Specific state agencies and institutions;**
14 **development of building projects; inclusion in state**
15 **building commission legislation; legislative approval**
16 **required.**

2 (a) For buildings, works or facilities the operation,
3 management and use of which are assigned by law to a
4 specific state agency or institution, including the
5 department of transportation, game and fish commission,
6 University of Wyoming and state institutions, the needs
7 assessments and construction and renovation priorities
8 submitted to the state building commission and legislature
9 pursuant to W.S. 9-5-107(e) shall be considered,
10 prioritized and incorporated by the state building
11 commission into the commission's legislation requesting
12 necessary funding, developed under W.S. 9-5-108(a)(ii)(J),
13 for submission to the legislature for review, authorization
14 and approval.

15

16 (b) This section shall apply only to capital
17 construction projects the total budget for which is in
18 excess of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

19

20 (c) No capital construction project to which this
21 section applies and the total budget for which is in excess
22 of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be commenced
23 without legislative approval.

2 (d) This section shall not apply to community college
3 district capital construction.

4

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
6 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
7 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
8 Constitution.
