A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle registration; providing  
2 registration timelines for members of the armed forces on  
3 deployment; making conforming amendments; and providing for  
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-201(a)(intro) and by creating a  
9 new subsection (q) is amended to read:

10

11 **31-2-201. Registration required; timelines.**

13 (a) Except as provided in W.S. 31-2-224 and  
14 subsection (q) of this section, every owner, or if  
15 applicable, operator or lessee, of a vehicle which will be

1 operated or driven upon any highway in Wyoming, shall be  
2 required to obtain registration at the following times:

3  
4 (q) Members of the armed forces who register their  
5 vehicles in Wyoming, are deployed outside the continental  
6 United States and whose vehicle registrations expire during  
7 their term of deployment shall be permitted to register  
8 their vehicles no later than fourteen (14) days after  
9 returning to Wyoming after deployment. The annual  
10 registration month of a vehicle registered under this  
11 subsection shall be the month in which the vehicle is  
12 registered after deployment. No fees or penalties shall be  
13 charged as a result of registration under this subsection  
14 and the registration fees charged shall be the same as  
15 otherwise provided in this article. Members who register  
16 under this subsection shall:

17  
18 (i) Provide to the county treasurer proper  
19 documentation of the deployment; and

20  
21 (ii) Attest that the vehicle to be registered  
22 was not driven between the date the vehicle registration  
23 expired and the date of registration under this subsection.

**Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2018.
