FISCAL NOTE

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

The Department of Corrections (DOC) states there is potential for expenditure reductions, but it is indeterminable. The bill provides for a reduced length of supervision for some offenders with potential for exceptions to increase supervision for good cause. The DOC states that there is no current way to accurately predict or estimate the number of individual offenders to be sentenced according to the bill. The cost of community supervision is approximately \$2,000 per year, per offender.
