**Catch Title:** **Hemp, cannabidiol and other controlled substance regulation.**

**Subject:** Regulation of hemp, cannabidiol and other controlled substances.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This bill removes hemp and hemp products from regulation by the Wyoming Controlled Substances Act.
- The bill requires the Attorney General, as Commissioner of Drugs and Substances Control, to conform Wyoming's controlled substance regulations to changes in federal law within a specified time period.
- The bill authorizes hemp production and hemp processing and provides rulemaking authority to the Department of Agriculture.
- The bill requires the Department of Agriculture to submit a state plan for the regulation of hemp to the United States Secretary of Agriculture.

**Comments:**

- Requires a report from the Department of Agriculture to the Joint Agriculture, Public Lands and Water Resources Interim Committee and the Joint Appropriations Committee on the production and processing of hemp.
