41 (m) In determining the amount to be included in the
42 foundation program for each district, the state
43 superintendent shall:

45 (v) Based upon ADM computations and identified
46 school configurations within each district pursuant to
47 paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute the foundation

1 program amount for each district as prescribed by the
2 education resource block grant model adopted by the Wyoming
3 legislature as defined under W.S. 21 13 101(a)(xiv), as
4 contained within the spreadsheets and accompanying reports
5 referenced under W.S. 21 13 101(a)(xvii). The following
6 criteria shall be used by the state superintendent in the
7 administration of the education resource block grant model:
8

9 (F) Amounts provided within the model for
10 health insurance shall be based upon:
11

12 (I) Prior year statewide average
13 district weighted actual participation in district health
14 insurance plans as to the proportion of employee only, split
15 contracts, employee plus spouse or children and family
16 coverage; ~~and~~

18 (II) The annualized state contribution
19 rate as of January 1 of the preceding school year, on behalf
20 of each employee and official enrolled in the state group
21 health insurance plan, for employee only, split contracts,
22 employee plus spouse or children and family coverage; and

24 (III) For school year 2020-2021 and
25 school year 2021-2022, the amount provided to a school
26 district for health insurance shall be calculated using the
27 annualized state contribution rate as of January 1, 2019 for
28 employee only, split contracts, employee plus spouse or
29 children and family coverage based on district weighted
30 actual participation in district health insurance plans for
31 the 2018-2019 school year, plus additional funding for each
32 school district employee actually enrolled in a school
33 district health insurance plan in the applicable preceding
34 school year calculated in accordance with the following:
35

36 (1) The department of education
37 shall calculate the number of model funded district employees
38 actually enrolled in a district health insurance plan for the
39 preceding school year;

41 (2) The department shall calculate
42 the difference between the annualized state contribution rate
43 as of January 1 of the preceding school year for employee
44 only, split contracts, employee plus spouse or children and
45 family coverage based on district weighted actual
46 participation in district health insurance plans for the
47 preceding school year and the annualized state contribution

1 rate as of January 1, 2019 for employee only, split contracts,
2 employee plus spouse or children and family coverage based on
3 district weighted actual participation in district health
4 insurance plans for the 2018-2019 school year;

7 provided to a school district under this subdivision shall be
8 the number of employees calculated under subdivision (1) of
9 this subdivision multiplied by the difference calculated
10 under subdivision (2) of this subdivision."

33 district provides each teacher employed by the district and
34 holding certification by the national board for professional
35 teaching standards a lump sum payment of four thousand dollars
36 (\$4,000.00), except that for school year 2020-2021 and school
37 year 2021-2022 a lump sum payment of two thousand dollars
38 (\$2,000.00) shall be made, which payment is in addition to
39 the teacher's annual salary as determined by the board, and
40 which is paid to each certified teacher between December 1
41 and December 31 of the school year for which application is
42 made;".
