14 "(a) Upon application, the appropriate licensing authority
15 shall issue a special malt beverage permit for the sale of malt
16 beverages only at events conducted on the grounds of an indoor or
17 outdoor rodeo. The permit may be issued without public notice or
18 hearing. An application for a permit under this section shall be
19 accompanied by a designation of the event for which the application
20 is sought specifying the type of event and the name of the sponsor.
21 The malt beverages shall be served only on grounds contiguous or
22 immediately adjacent to the arena in areas specifically designated
23 by the permittee and approved by the licensing authority.
24 Contiguous or adjacent grounds shall be fenced or otherwise
25 enclosed as approved by the licensing authority. The issuance of
26 a malt beverage permit under this subsection shall not be
27 considered an alcoholic beverage permit issued on the basis of
28 population as provided in W.S. 12-4-201. Malt beverages shall only
29 be sold for consumption under a permit issued under this section
30 during the dates of an event. W.S. 12-5-201 shall not apply to
31 this section."
