Livestock board investigators.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to livestock board investigators;
2 authorizing payment of livestock board investigators from
3 the inspection account; increasing the animal remedies
4 registration fee and amending distribution; and providing
5 for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-17-204(b) and 11-20-405(a) are
10 amended to read:

11

12 **11-17-204. Registration; fees; audit; investigator**
13 **special revenue account.**

1 (b) Every registrant of animal remedies shall pay a
2 registration fee of ~~twenty dollars (\$20.00)~~ forty dollars
3 (\$40.00) per product. Of this fee, twenty dollars (\$20.00)
4 shall be deposited into the general fund and twenty dollars
5 (\$20.00) shall be deposited into the inspection account.

7 **11-20-405. Collection and disposition.**

8

9 (a) Any funds appropriated by the legislature and all
10 fees collected pursuant to W.S. 11-20-101 through
11 11-20-124, 11-20-201 through 11-20-230, 11-20-401 and
12 11-20-402 shall be remitted to the state treasurer for
13 deposit in the inspection account. Interest earned by the
14 account shall be retained in the account. Monies within the
15 account are subject to legislative review and appropriation
16 for use and expenditure by the board. Itemized vouchers
17 shall be submitted to the chief executive officer of the
18 board for approval. Upon approval, a warrant for the
19 payment of each voucher shall be issued by the state
20 auditor for payment from the inspection account. The board
21 shall expend monies from the account created by this
22 section only for the purposes authorized by W.S. 11-20-201
23 through 11-20-230₇ and 11-20-101 through 11-20-124 and to

1 pay for investigators of the Wyoming livestock board who
2 are peace officers as defined in W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E).

3

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
