A BILL

for

1	AN ACT relating to education; authorizing the state
2	superintendent of public instruction to employ a state
3	school nurse; specifying duties of the state school nurse;
4	authorizing a position subject to conditions; and providing
5	for effective dates.
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7	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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9	Section 1. W.S. 21-2-202(a) by creating new
10	paragraphs (xxxviii) and (xxxix) is amended to read:
11	
12	21-2-202. Duties of the state superintendent.
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(a) In addition to any other duties assigned by law,
 the state superintendent shall:

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4 (xxxviii) When nonstate funds are received by 5 the department of education that provide for one hundred percent (100%) of the cost, the state superintendent may 6 hire the state school nurse as an at-will contract employee 7 8 or may contract for nursing services to carry out the duties assigned under this paragraph. The state school 9 10 nurse shall hold a Wyoming license as a registered nurse. 11 The state school nurse shall:

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13 <u>(A) Identify professional development needs</u>
14 for Wyoming school nurses, with focus on caring for
15 students with behavioral health needs and chronic diseases
16 and make available training resources to meet the
17 professional development needs identified;
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19 <u>(B) Assist the superintendent in</u> 20 <u>establishing recommendations for school district policies</u> 21 <u>and training regarding the use of seclusion and restraint</u> 22 <u>in schools pursuant to paragraph (xxxii) of this</u> 23 subsection;

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2	(C) Assist the superintendent in developing
3	protocols to address risks associated with concussions and
4	<u>head injuries under W.S. 21-3-110(a)(xxxii);</u>
5	
6	(D) Assist the superintendent in reviewing
7	and making available suicide prevention education materials
8	as required under paragraph(xxxv) of this subsection;
9	
10	(E) In consultation with the state health
11	officer and the district boards of trustees, obtain
12	standing orders for medication administration or treatment
13	for students without a primary care physician who have
14	urgent needs during the school day;
15	
16	(F) Assist the superintendent in drafting
17	recommendations for school district use to help facilitate
18	care for behavioral health needs, enhance collaboration
19	among school district personnel and community medical and
20	behavioral health providers, and to prevent disease,
21	substance abuse and bullying;

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1	(G) Provide information to school nurses
2	and school district boards of trustees on public health
3	issues;
4	
5	(H) In a manner to maintain student
6	confidentiality, collect aggregated data from school
7	districts on medical and behavioral health diagnoses,
8	vision and hearing impairment, special education needs, and
9	other nursing challenges that impact schools and students;
10	
11	(J) In consultation with the board of
12	nursing, develop best practice standards for school
13	nursing;
14	
15	(K) At the request of district boards of
16	trustees, advise on the child sexual abuse education,
17	prevention and response program under W.S. 21-3-133.
18	
19	(xxxix) Solicit nonstate funds for costs
20	associated with the position of the state school nurse.
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22	

Section 2. The department of education shall take all
 action necessary to implement section 1 of this act by July
 1, 2020.

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Section 3. The department of education is authorized 5 one (1) at-will contract employee position or may contract 6 7 nursing services in accordance for with W.S. 21-2-202(a)(xxxviii), as created by this act, contingent on 8 the availability of nonstate funds. Any nonstate funds 9 10 become available for the that purposes of W.S. 11 21-2-202(a)(xxxviii), as created by this act, shall be 12 accepted through the B-11 process as authorized by W.S. 9-2-1005(b)(ii) and (g) and reported pursuant to W.S. 13 9-2-1013(b). It is the intent of the legislature that this 14 position and the associated funds be included in the 15 16 department of education's 2023-2024 budget request.

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20 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this21 section, this act is effective July 1, 2020.

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1 (b) Sections 2 through 4 of this act are effective 2 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a 3 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of 4 the Wyoming Constitution.
