8	Section 1. W.S. 28-11-601 is created to read:

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28-11-601. Appointment of members; powers and duties.

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1 (a) Not later than March 15 following each general 2 election, a select committee on tribal relations shall be 3 appointed subject to the following: 4 5 (i) The president of the senate shall appoint three (3) members of the senate apportioned as nearly as 6 possible to reflect the percentage of the elected 7 8 membership of the majority and minority parties of the 9 senate, provided not more than two (2) of the members shall 10 be from the same political party. The president of the 11 shall designate a co-chairman of the senate 12 committee; 13 14 (ii) The speaker of the house of representatives 15 shall appoint three (3) members of the house apportioned as nearly as possible to reflect the percentage of the elected 16 17 membership of the majority and minority parties of the house, provided not more than two (2) of the members shall 18 19 be from the same political party. The speaker of the house 20 shall designate a co-chairman of the select committee.

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22 (b) The select committee shall:

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1	(i) Develop knowledge and expertise among its								
2	members regarding matters pertaining to Indian tribes in								
3	the state and services and needs on the Wind River Indian								
4	Reservation. Consideration of the topics in this paragraph								
5	shall include health and safety, water, education,								
6	transportation, gaming, communications, law enforcement and								
7	legal services, infrastructure, land and resources,								
8	minerals, revenue, economic development and other issues								
9	that are a concern to the residents on and near the Wind								
10	River Indian Reservation as approved by management council;								
11									
12	(ii) Facilitate and foster communication and								
13	robust working relationships among state, tribal, federal								
14	and local entities and pursue opportunities for encouraging								
15	economic growth, nondiscrimination and wellbeing for								
16	residents of the Wind River Indian Reservation and								
17	neighboring communities;								
18									
19	(iii) Develop and introduce legislation as								
20	necessary. If any draft legislation developed by the select								
21	committee relates to a topic area of a joint interim								
22	committee the legislation shall be submitted to the								
23	appropriate legislative committee for comment and								

1	consideration	prior	to th	e joint	ınterım	committee'	s	last
2	scheduled inte	erim me	eting.					

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4 **Section 2.** Within thirty (30) days after the

5 effective date of this act the president of the senate and

6 the speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint

7 members to the select committee on tribal relations in

8 accordance with the requirements of W.S. 28-11-601(a), as

9 created by this act.

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11 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon

12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

14 Constitution.
