**Catch Title:** **Mountain daylight time preservation.**

**Subject:** Wyoming daylight saving time made year round.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- The bill would place Wyoming on Mountain daylight time year round.

**Comments:**

- The bill will not take effect until the first Sunday of November following:
  - Legislation enacted by Congress amending 15 U.S.C. § 260a to allow states to observe daylight saving time year round.
  - Four (4) western states, including Wyoming, having passed legislation to adopt year round daylight saving time.
- The Governor shall inform the Management Council of the legislature of the date this bill takes effect.
