21 (d) The governing body of a municipality may remove the full-22 time or part-time health officer of a municipal health department. The governing body of a county may remove the full-time or part-23 24 time health officer of a county health department. The governing 25 bodies of each political subdivision participating in a district health department may jointly act to remove the full-time or part-26 27 time district health department officer by a majority vote of each governing body voting separately. The authority provided in this 28 29 subsection is in addition to the authority of a local board of 30 health to remove the full-time or part-time health officer. 31
