25 of law, shall not expend the funds or disburse the funds to any
26 political subdivision within the state if, as a condition of
27 receipt, expenditure or disbursement of the funds, the agency
28 accepting the funds or any political subdivision to which the funds
29 would be disbursed would be obligated to meet any maintenance of
30 effort or maintenance of equity requirement that is increased from
31 or did not exist at the time of enactment of the legislative act
32 authorizing acceptance of, or providing the initial appropriation
33 of, the federal funds. The prohibitions in this subsection shall
34 not be applicable to federal funds authorized by a federal
35 enactment which is specifically identified by a state legislative
36 act explicitly appropriating the federal funds or explicitly
37 approving the acceptance of the federal funds.

41 (i) "State agency" shall not include the Wyoming
42 department of transportation, the game and fish department, the
43 University of Wyoming, the Wyoming community college commission or
