- (a) Each district which meets the following requirements is eligible to share in the distribution of funds from the foundation account:
- (ii) Operated all schools for a term of at least one hundred eighty-five (185) one hundred eighty-two (182) days or the number of days or equivalent hours authorized under an alternative schedule approved by the state board during the previous school year. If the school term of any school in a district was less than one hundred eighty-five (185) one hundred eighty-two (182) days or less than the total number of days authorized under an alternative schedule approved by the state board, the amount allotted per average daily membership (ADM) under W.S. 21-13-309 for the school shall be in proportion to the length of the term the school actually operated, unless caused by closures of schools: ".
