11 (a) There is appropriated ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the legislative stabilization reserve 12 13 account to the Wyoming energy authority subject to approval by the University of Wyoming energy resources council and the governor to 14 15 match research grants and contracts related to carbon capture, utilization and storage, including coal power plant retrofit and 16 17 other carbon capture, utilization and storage applications, conditioned upon a match of funds in the ratio of one dollar 18 19 (\$1.00) of appropriated funds to not less than one dollar (\$1.00) 20 of matching funds. This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and shall only revert upon further 21 22 act of the legislature.
