(ix) One (1) member of the Wyoming house of representatives who shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

(b) All members shall be appointed on or before May 1, 2021. The task force shall exist until May 1, 2022. Any vacancy occurring on the task force shall be filled by the appointing authority outlined in this section, as appropriate.

(c) In consultation with relevant stakeholders, the task force shall examine educational programs provided by schools pursuant to W.S. 21-9-101 and alternatives and recommend modifications to existing educational programs to ensure the system of public schools is thorough, efficient and adequate. The task force shall report its recommendations to the joint education interim committee. The legislative service office, on behalf of the task force and subject to the approval of management council, may retain a professional consultant with experience in national educational program best practices to assist the task force with the examination of programs and alternatives, recommendations and reporting. The report to the joint education interim committee shall be submitted not later than May 1, 2022.

 (d) The legislators shall receive salary, per diem and mileage expenses in the manner and amount prescribed by W.S. 28-5-101, but no salary for preparation. Task force members appointed by the president of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives shall receive no salary but shall receive per diem and mileage expenses in the same manner and amount as legislators as prescribed by W.S. 28-5-101. Task force members who are not legislators, legislative appointees or state or local government employees shall receive no compensation but shall receive per diem and mileage expenses in the same manner and amount provided under W.S. 9-3-102 and 9-3-103. A state or local government employee's service on the task force shall be considered within the scope of the employee's regular duties.

 (e) There is appropriated from the general fund for the purposes of this section thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) to the legislative service office for payment of salary, per diem and mileage for legislators, payment of mileage and per diem for other legislative appointees and to retain professional services. Any unexpended and unobligated funds shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2022.

- (f) There is appropriated from the general fund for the purposes of this section three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) to the department of education for payment of per diem and mileage for committee members appointed by the state superintendent of public instruction entitled to payment of mileage and per diem under subsection (d) of this section. Any unexpended and unobligated funds shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2022.
