## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; authorizing rules to
- 2 provide for the collection of road killed animals;
- 3 providing restrictions; imposing a prior authorization fee;
- 4 and providing for an effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-3-310 is created to read:

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10 23-3-310. Possession of road killed wildlife.

- 12 (a) The commission shall, in consultation with the
- 13 state transportation commission, adopt rules to establish a
- 14 program whereby any person desiring to possess wildlife
- 15 killed as a result of unintentional motor vehicle

- 1 collisions on any public road or highway in the state of
- 2 Wyoming is permitted to do so, provided that he collects
- 3 the entire road killed animal, both edible and inedible
- 4 portions and possesses one (1) of the following:

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- 6 (i) A certificate of prior authorization from
- 7 the department. Certificates of prior authorization may be
- 8 issued through the director to any person or entity which
- 9 commits to putting road killed wildlife carcasses to a
- 10 beneficial use. A certificate shall only be issued for a
- 11 fee of forty dollars (\$40.00). The department shall deposit
- 12 fifty percent (50%) of the fees collected under this
- 13 paragraph into the Wyoming game and fish fund and the
- 14 remaining fifty percent (50%) shall be transmitted to the
- 15 state treasurer to be credited to the wildlife conservation
- 16 account created by W.S. 31-2-231(b);

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- 18 (ii) A valid scientific or educational
- 19 collecting license for the specific species issued pursuant
- 20 to W.S. 23-1-302(a)(xiii); or

- 22 (iii) A donation certificate or Wyoming
- 23 interstate game tag issued by the department, including a

- 1 certificate or tag issued electronically. Unless otherwise
- 2 provided by rule of the commission, a person desiring to
- 3 possess a road killed animal shall contact the department
- 4 before taking possession of an animal to obtain a donation
- 5 certificate. The rules may provide that a person requesting
- 6 the donation certificate may have to present the animal for
- 7 inspection to verify its possession meets the criteria of
- 8 the regulation.

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- 10 (b) None of the provisions of this section shall
- 11 apply to bighorn sheep, gray wolves within any area of the
- 12 state where gray wolves are classified as trophy game
- 13 animals, grizzly bears, mountain goats, wildlife species
- 14 covered under the federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act,
- 15 federal threatened or endangered species or those species
- 16 whose possession is prohibited by federal or state statute
- 17 or regulation.

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- 19 (c) Nothing in this section shall authorize the
- 20 possession of any illegally taken wildlife or wildlife
- 21 found dead.

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1 (d) request of Upon the state transportation 2 commission, the commission shall exempt segments of public 3 road or highway from the program established pursuant to 4 this section. 5 **Section 2.** W.S. 23-3-106(a)(i), (ii) and by creating 6 7 a new paragraph (iii) is amended to read: 8 9 23-3-106. Wyoming game and Wyoming interstate game 10 tags; when required. 11 12 (a) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this 13 23-2-302(e), no person shall section and W.S. transport, or receive for shipment or transportation within 14 Wyoming, any game animal, game bird, or any part thereof, 15 16 unless tagged with a Wyoming game tag or Wyoming interstate 17 game tag, or unless: 18

19 (i) The transportation is by а person 20 accompanying the carcass of a big or trophy game animal who 21 is in possession of a proper coupon; or

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(ii) The transportation is by a properly
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    licensed bird or small game hunter in possession of not

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              (iii) The transportation is by a person
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    possessing authorization pursuant to W.S. 23-3-310.
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         Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
