- 15 assessor as provided by the Wyoming Election Code of 1973

- 1 as amended, who shall be a qualified elector and own real

- 4 county assessor serves, beginning on the first day of the
- 5 term and through the last day of the term for which the
- 6 <u>county assessor serves.</u>
