- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 33-1-303 by creating new subsections
- 10 (b) through (d) is amended to read:

12 33-1-303. Powers of licensure boards.

- 14 (b) A board authorized to establish examination,
- 15 <u>inspection</u>, <u>permit or license fees for any profession or</u>

1	occupation regulated under this title or under W.S.
2	21-2-802 or 23-2-414 may waive or modify statutory
3	examination or continuing education requirements or other
4	statutory requirements for licensure or permitting if:
5	
6	(i) The examination is not being given or is not
7	<pre>practicably available;</pre>
8	
9	(ii) Continuing education opportunities are not
10	<pre>practicably available; or</pre>
11	
12	(iii) The statutory requirement could not be met
13	due to public health orders or weather conditions.
14	
15	(c) The relevant licensing or certifying authority
16	may impose reasonable or necessary restrictions or
17	requirements on a license, certification or practice
18	authority affected by a waiver or modification granted
19	pursuant to subsection (b) of this section.
20	
21	(d) If the duration of a waiver or modification
22	granted pursuant to subsection (b) of this section exceeds
23	two (2) years, the relevant licensing or certifying

1	authority shall report the matter to the appropriate
2	legislative committee and recommend any appropriate related
3	statutory amendments. For health related occupations the
4	relevant committee shall be the joint labor, health and
5	social services interim committee and for all other matters
6	the relevant committee shall be the joint corporations,
7	elections and political subdivisions interim committee. No
8	waiver or modification granted under subsection (b) of this
9	section shall have a duration of more than four (4) years.

11	Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon
12	completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13	as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14	Constitution.
