8 **Section 1.** W.S. 34-1-154 is created to read:

- 12 (a) The ownership of any fossil, artifact or non-
- 13 fossilized animal remains discovered in the strata below
- 14 the surface lands and waters of the state is vested in the

- owner of the surface estate, unless otherwise governed by 1
- 2 W.S. 7-4-106.

- 4 (b) When used in any instrument, the term "minerals"
- does not include fossils, artifacts or non-fossilized 5
- animal remains. 6

(c) As used in this section: 8

- 10 (i) "Fossil" means any fossilized remains,
- traces or imprints of organisms, preserved in or on the 11
- 12 earth's crust, that are of paleontological interest and
- that provide information about the history of life on 13
- earth, but does not include coal, oil, gas or other 14
- hydrocarbons; 15

- 17 (ii) "Artifact" means any material remains of
- past human life or human activities that are of 18
- 19 archaeological interest.

20

- 21 Section 2. This act shall apply to any existing or
- future transfer of ownership of the strata below the 22
- surface lands and waters of the state. 23

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
