

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0002

School buildings and facilities study.

Sponsored by: Select Committee on School Facilities

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school buildings and facilities;  
2 requiring a study on the suitability, capacity and  
3 condition of school buildings and facilities; authorizing  
4 contracting with a consultant; requiring reporting;  
5 providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective  
6 date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

10 **Section 1.**

11

12 (a) The school facilities commission shall study the  
13 suitability, capacity and condition of all public school  
14 buildings and school facilities in Wyoming. The state  
15 construction department, as approved by the commission, may

1 contract with a consultant to assist with the study  
2 required by this act.

4 (b) The school facilities commission shall provide  
5 updates on the study required by this act at the request of  
6 the joint appropriations committee or the select committee  
7 on school facilities. Not later than October 15, 2021, the  
8 school facilities commission shall report to the joint  
9 appropriations committee and the select committee on school  
10 facilities on the status of the study required by this act.

11

12 **Section 2.** There is appropriated six million dollars  
13 (\$6,000,000.00) from the strategic investments and projects  
14 account to the state construction department for the  
15 purposes of this act. This appropriation shall be for the  
16 period beginning with the effective date of this act and  
17 ending June 30, 2022. This appropriation shall not be  
18 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any  
19 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this  
20 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,  
21 2022. It is the intent of the legislature that this  
22 appropriation not be included in the state construction

1 department's standard budget for the immediately succeeding  
2 fiscal biennium.

4       **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon  
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
7 Constitution.
