6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1307(b)(viii), (d) by creating  
9 a new paragraph (vii) and (e) by creating a new paragraph  
10 (iv) is amended to read:

12 **21-16-1307. Success curriculum; test standards.**

14 (b) Except as otherwise provided for by law, the  
15 success curriculum required to qualify for honor or  
16 performance scholarship eligibility under this article for

1 students graduating from high school in the 2019-2020  
2 school year and each school year thereafter shall be as  
3 follows:

5 (viii) Notwithstanding the requirements in  
6 ~~paragraph~~ paragraphs (ii) through (iv) and (vii) of this  
7 subsection and as provided in paragraph (i) of this  
8 subsection for courses to be taken in grades nine (9)  
9 through twelve (12), courses taken before grade nine (9)  
10 that are the functional equivalent of courses specified in  
11 ~~paragraph (vii) of this subsection~~ those paragraphs may be  
12 used to satisfy ~~not more than one (1) year of~~ the  
13 requirements ~~in paragraph (vii) of those paragraphs~~ of this

5 used to satisfy the requirements of those paragraphs of

8 (e) The success curriculum required to qualify for  
9 provisional opportunity scholarship eligibility under this  
10 article for students graduating from high school in the  
11 2010-2011 school year and each school year thereafter shall  
12 be the curriculum required for high school graduation under  
13 W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii) subject to the following:

15 (iv) For purposes of paragraph (i) of this  
16 subsection and as provided in paragraph (iii) of this  
17 subsection, courses taken before grade nine (9) that are  
18 the functional equivalent of courses specified in those  
19 paragraphs may be used to satisfy the requirements of those  
20 paragraphs of this subsection.
