Statewide health information exchange-codification.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
2 codifying the statewide health information exchange;
3 authorizing the department of health to administer and
4 maintain the exchange; authorizing the department to
5 establish fees for participation in the exchange; providing
6 rulemaking authority; and providing for effective dates.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-131 is created to read:

11

12 **9-2-131. Wyoming health information exchange.**

13

14 (a) This section codifies the statewide health
15 information exchange authorized by 2016 Wyoming Session

1 Laws, Chapter 31, Section 048, except that the term
2 "multi-payer" in that section shall not be codified or
3 impose any requirements on the operation of the information
4 exchange as provided for under this section. The department
5 of health is authorized to administer and maintain the
6 exchange to facilitate the secure and voluntary sharing of
7 electronic health information between health care providers
8 for the benefit of Wyoming residents.

9

10 (b) The department may charge reasonable
11 participation fees to participating entities, which shall
12 not include individual patients, subject to the following:

13

14 (i) Fees shall be established by rule
15 promulgated in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative
16 Procedure Act;

17

18 (ii) Fees shall be established in an amount
19 sufficient to recoup the department's costs for
20 administering and maintaining the exchange in accordance
21 with this section; and

22

1 (iii) Fees collected by the department pursuant
2 to this section shall be credited to a special revenue
3 account, which shall be expended only for administration
4 and maintenance costs associated with operating the
5 statewide health information exchange.

6

7 **Section 2.** The department shall adopt rules as
8 necessary to implement and administer the statewide health
9 information exchange and participation fees authorized by
10 this act on or before July 1, 2021, provided these rules
11 shall not take effect until July 1, 2021.

12

13 **Section 3.**

14

15 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of
16 this section, this act is effective July 1, 2021.

17

18 (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective
19 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
20 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
21 the Wyoming Constitution.
