A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to ad valorem taxation; authorizing the
2 department of revenue to release information related to
3 state assessed property to the county assessor of the
4 county where the property is located; and providing for an
5 effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-13-102(q)(ii)(A) is amended to
10 read:

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12 **39-13-102. Administration; confidentiality.**

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14 (q) Confidentiality. The following shall apply:

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1 (ii) Without written authorization from the
2 taxpayer, no current or former official, officer, employee
3 or agent of the state of Wyoming or any political
4 subdivision thereof shall release taxpayer returns and
5 return information pertaining to taxes imposed by this
6 chapter, except:

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8 (A) Information filed with the department
9 may be released to the governor or his designee, members of
10 the state board of equalization, to the commissioners and
11 employees of the public service commission, to employees of
12 the department of audit, the department of revenue, the
13 consensus revenue estimating group and to the attorney
14 general. Information related to state assessed property may
15 be released upon request to the county assessor of a county
16 where the property is located. Information filed with the
17 county assessor may be released to the county board of
18 equalization, the department of revenue and the department
19 of audit;

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21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2021.
