Catch Title: Consumer credit amendments.

Subject: Amending the Uniform Consumer Credit Code.

Summary/Major Elements:

• This act amends various provisions of Wyoming's Uniform Consumer Credit Code.

- The act authorizes sales-finance activities for certain licensees and establishes procedures and calculations for the refund of certain credit-insurance products upon prepayment.
- The act exempts certain supervised financial institutions from certain notice and fee requirements in the Code.
- The act generally restructures the Code to repeal statutes for consumer-related loans and supervised loans, consolidating the provisions for those loans into existing laws for consumer loans.
- The act applies to agreements entered into on or after July 1, 2021 and to licenses issued or renewed on or after July 1, 2021.
