Catch Title: **Driver's license requirements-visual acuity.**
Subject: Requiring demonstration of visual acuity for driver's license.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current laws to ensure adequate vision for those applying for a driver's license or a renewal driver's license state that the Wyoming Department of Transportation Division of Driver Services will "examine" applicants or require them to "take and successfully pass a test," which could be interpreted as the applicant needing to physically enter facilities for the vision test.
- This act amends requirements for a person applying for a driver's license to "demonstrate adequate visual acuity according to department rules." The act also standardizes the language among the provisions for applying for a driver's license, a renewal license and an instructional permit.
