Catch Title: Game road kill.

Subject: Road killed animals.

Summary/Major Elements:

• This bill requires the game and fish commission, in consultation with the state transportation commission, to adopt rules to establish a program allowing a person desiring to possess wildlife killed as a result of an unintentional vehicle collision to do so.

- The bill requires the person to collect the entire animal and possess a donation certificate issued by the Wyoming game and fish department.
- The program excludes bighorn sheep, gray wolves where classified as trophy game, grizzly bears, mountain goats, wildlife covered under the federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act, federal threatened or endangered species, or species whose possession is prohibited by state or federal law or regulation and may exclude specified segments of public roads or highways.
