Catch Title: **Pioneer trapper license.**

Subject: Resident pioneer trapping license.

Summary/Major Elements:

- The act creates a “pioneer resident trapping license” to allow the taking of furbearing animals.
- To be eligible for a license, a person must be a resident for at least thirty (30) years prior to the issuance of the license and be at least sixty-five (65) years of age.
- The license costs twenty dollars (\$20.00).
- The act requires the Wyoming Game and Fish Department to promulgate rules to implement the act.
