**Subject:** University of Wyoming water system rights.

**Summary/Major Elements:**

- This act authorizes the University of Wyoming to develop, use and maintain a water line, water system, well or water works on University property for the purposes of applying nonpotable water on property owned or leased by the University for landscape watering, lawns, athletic fields, trees, shrubs and flowers.
- The act authorizes the University to connect any building, facility, landscape, lot, premises or University owned structure to any water line, system, well or works operated, maintained or used by the University.
- The act prohibits any city or county from constraining the University from developing, using or maintaining any water system independent of the city's or county's water system.
