15 months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars  
16 (\$750.00), or both.

18 (c) Notwithstanding the penalty imposed under subsection (b)  
19 of this section, any person who intentionally violates this section  
20 on account of a person's COVID-19 vaccination status commits a  
21 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than fifty dollars  
22 (\$50.00) subject to the following conditions:

24 (i) Notwithstanding the authority granted under W.S. 7-  
25 2-102(b)(i), a peace officer shall not arrest a person without a  
26 warrant for an alleged violation of this section and may only issue  
27 a citation as a charging document.

29 (d) As used in this section:

31 (i) "COVID-19" means as defined by W.S. 1-1-141(a)(ii);

33 (ii) "COVID-19 vaccination" means any vaccine that is  
34 marketed to prevent COVID-19 or any vaccine that is marketed to  
35 diminish or decrease the symptoms of COVID-19;

37 (iii) "COVID-19 vaccination status" means evidence of  
38 whether a person has received one (1) or more doses of a COVID-19
