9 (a) There is appropriated ten million dollars
10 (\$10,000,000.00) to the department of workforce services from any
11 unexpended, unobligated American Rescue Plan Act funds that were
12 appropriated in 2021 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 166, Section
13 5(b). This appropriation is for purposes of implementing a program
14 through the department of workforce services to provide COVID-19
15 tests and COVID-19 antibody tests to employers that adopt a
16 COVID-19 vaccine mandate that conforms to the requirements of
17 section 2(a) of this act, as enacted into law. This appropriation
18 shall be expended consistent with the terms of the American Rescue
19 Plan Act, excluding the provision of government services related
20 to a reduction in revenue. The department may promulgate rules
21 and regulations as necessary for the enforcement of this section,
22 including adopting emergency rules. The program created under this
23 section shall expire on March 31, 2022. Any unobligated, unexpended
24 funds remaining from this appropriation on June 1, 2022, may be
25 transferred and expended upon approval by the governor for any
26 other purpose authorized by the legislature and consistent with
27 the terms of the American Rescue Plan Act. Transfers and
28 expenditures under this subsection shall be reported to the
29 legislature through the B-11 process as authorized by W.S.
30 9-2-1005(b)(ii) and reported pursuant to W.S. 9-2-1013(b).

32 (b) The appropriation in this section shall not take effect
33 if a substantially similar program to the one described in
34 subsection (a) of this section is otherwise enacted into law during
35 the October and November 2021 special session of the legislature."
