Wyoming gaming commission-scrivener error correction-2.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming gaming commission; providing
2 legislative findings; correcting a scrivener's error in
3 previous legislation; demonstrating legislative intent to
4 secure uninterrupted membership under the Wyoming
5 retirement system for specified Wyoming gaming commission
6 personnel; and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.**

11

12 (a) The legislature finds that:

13

14 (i) As a result of the 2021 General Session of
15 the Wyoming Legislature, 2021 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter

1 109 (original 2021 Senate File 0056) ("2021 Act") became
2 law. The 2021 Act intended to repeal Section 1 of 2020
3 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 114 (original 2020 House Bill
4 0171) ("2020 Act") and to codify and otherwise address all
5 issues contained in Section 1 of the 2020 Act;

6

7 (ii) The 2021 Act was not intended to repeal the
8 2020 Act in its entirety. However, due to a scrivener's
9 error, the 2021 Act omitted a reference to "Section 1" in
10 Section 6, the "repealer section" and instead stated, "2020
11 Wyoming Sessions Laws, Chapter 114 is repealed[;]";

12

13 (iii) Repeal of the entire 2020 Act was not
14 intended by the legislature in the 2021 Act;

15

16 (iv) The legislature finds it necessary to
17 clarify its intent and to enact into law appropriate
18 legislation, as contained in this act.

20 **Section 2.** 2021 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 109,
21 Section 6 is amended to read:

22

1 **Section 6.** 2020 Wyoming Session Laws,
2 Chapter 114, Section 1 is repealed.

3

4 **Section 3.** The legislature ratifies the participation
5 of Wyoming gaming commission law enforcement officers in
6 the Wyoming retirement system under the Wyoming Retirement
7 Act and authorizes all contributions made on their behalf
8 from the period of April 5, 2021 to the effective date of
9 this act.

10

11 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon
12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
14 Constitution.
