9 (\$1,000,000.00) is appropriated to provide grants to any agency or
10 political subdivision of the state for nonmotorized natural
11 surface trails, including trails for hiking, horse riding or
12 mountain biking, and planning for active recreation projects that
13 encourage increased hiking, biking or horse riding. The grants
14 shall be administered in the same manner as the current Wyoming
15 recreational trails program administered by the department. Up to
16 seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) of this appropriation may be
17 used for agency administration of the grant program required under
18 this footnote.

10 path networks on existing roads, sidewalk and crosswalk networks,
11 projects to develop walkable main street corridor, or active
12 transportation planning that encourage increased transportation by

14 manner as the current transportation alternatives program
15 administered by the department. Up to six hundred thirty thousand
16 dollars (\$630,000.00) of this appropriation may be used for agency
