Section 323.
(a) W.S. 9-4-219(b) is amended to read:

9-4-219. Legislative stabilization reserve account created; purposes; legislative deficit control account.
(b) To the extent funds are available after all other appropriations or transfers from the legislative stabilization reserve account to be made on or prior to June 30 of the applicable fiscal year have been made, an amount necessary to restore the unobligated, unencumbered balance within the public school foundation program account to one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000.00) on June 30 of each fiscal year shall be transferred from the legislative stabilization reserve account into the public school foundation program account. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection this subsection is repealed the month immediately following the date that the state auditor and the state treasurer first certify to the governor and the department of revenue, and the governor certifies the same to the secretary of state, that the unobligated, unencumbered balance in the legislative stabilization reserve account is less than five hundred million dollars (\$500,000,000.00). During fiscal years

2022 and 2023, this subsection shall be repealed in the month immediately following the date that the state auditor and the state treasurer first certify to the governor and the department of revenue, and the governor certifies the same to the secretary of state, that the unobligated, unencumbered balance in the legislative stabilization reserve account is less than one billion two hundred fifty million dollars (\$1,250,000,000.00).
(b) This section is effective immediately.".
