15 dollars (\$258,000.00) from the school foundation program account
16 to the department of agriculture for the period beginning July 1,
17 2022 and ending June 30, 2024 to be expended only for matching
18 funds for grants for weed and pest control on state school lands.
19 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, funds from this
20 appropriation shall only be expended after each grant applicant
21 provides a match of at least one dollar (\$1.00) from any source
22 for every one dollar (\$1.00) requested from this appropriation.
23 The matching requirement of this subsection shall not be required
24 if the applicant is the office of state lands and investments for
25 weed and pest control on state school lands. It is the intent of
26 the legislature that this appropriation be included in the
27 department of agriculture's standard budget request for the
28 immediately succeeding fiscal biennium.

30 (c) There is appropriated forty-two thousand dollars
31 (\$42,000.00) from the general fund to the department of agriculture
32 for the period beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2024 to
33 be expended only for matching funds for grants for weed and pest
34 control on state lands that are not state school lands. Except as
35 otherwise provided in this subsection, funds from this
36 appropriation shall only be expended after each grant applicant
37 provides a match of at least one dollar (\$1.00) from any source
38 for every one dollar (\$1.00) requested from this appropriation.
39 The matching requirement of this subsection shall not be required
40 if the applicant is the office of state lands and investments for
41 weed and pest control on state lands that are not state school
42 lands. It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation
43 be included in the department of agriculture's standard budget
44 request for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium."
