3           "(d) The state superintendent of public instruction shall  
4 appoint an appeals board to hear appeals pursuant to this  
5 subsection and subsections (e) and (f) of this section. Appeals  
6 shall only be heard on the issue of whether a student is being  
7 properly denied or should be denied participation on a team or in  
8 a sport designated for females in accordance with this chapter. At  
9 the request of an appealing student, the board shall deem the  
10 student's medical information confidential and shall not disclose  
11 that information. If the appeals board finds that a student does  
12 not possess in a sufficient quantity the normal male physical  
13 capabilities to present a threat of unfair competition to a normal  
14 female who wishes to participate on the team or in the sport, the  
15 appeals board shall grant permission for the student to participate  
16 on the team or in the sport.  
17

18           (e) The appeals board shall consist of either three (3) or  
19 five (5) members, as determined by the state superintendent.  
20 Members on the appeals board shall serve two (2) year terms. The  
21 appeals board shall include at least one (1) member with experience  
22 coaching a team or individual sport and shall include at least one  
23 (1) member who is a health care professional whose professional  
24 training or experience gives the professional an understanding of  
25 the normal comparative physical capabilities of males and females  
26 related to athletic performance. Board members who are not state  
27 employees, employees of the University of Wyoming or employees of  
28 a school district or community college shall receive travel  
29 expenses, per diem and mileage expenses in the same manner and  
30 amount as state legislators.

32           (f) The following persons shall have the right to appeal an  
33 adverse decision under this chapter to the appeals board:  
34

35           (i) Any student otherwise eligible to participate in a  
36 sport or on a team by virtue of their status as a student who is  
37 denied eligibility to participate under subsection (b) of this  
38 section, and that student's parents or guardian;

40           (ii) Any female student, or that student's parents or  
41 guardian, who believes she is being denied the opportunity to  
42 compete fairly by the presence of a person whose participation is  
43 prohibited under subsection (b) of this section.". SCOTT, CHAIRMAN
